




Line Graph Grammar

While most line graphs show a period that **started and finished in the past**, some show a period that **starts in the past and continues to the present**, or a period that **starts in the past and continues into the future**.


Ex. 1 Which periods do these line graphs show?

Throughout the period, there was a dramatic increase in the price of rice and pasta.

Between 1999 and 2004, the price of rice, which stood at \$0.4 in 1999, rocketed to \$0.75 per kilogram before dipping slightly to \$0.70 in 2005. In the next year, the price recovered quickly to \$0.75, and by the end of the period, the price had reached a high of \$1.25.
